DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 24.7.2018, FDRs have been returned by the Investigating Officer and thereafter the same have been deposited with the Punjab National Bank. Learned counsel further contends that a certificate in this regard has also been issued by the Bank and the same has been affirmed by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

However, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner be directed to hand over his passport to the investigating officer.

The passport be deposited with the investigating officer and in case the same is required for any purpose, an appropriate application be moved before the trial Court.

In view of the above, interim order dated 5.4.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.
