On 15.03.2018, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in FIR No.312 dated 10.11.2013 under Section 304-A IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Uchana, District Jind, petitioner was granted bail and he was regularly appearing in the Court. On account of lodging of FIR No.288 dated 10.09.2014 under Sections 386, 285 IPC registered at Police Station Julana, District Jind by the petitioner and on account of threat perception received from the accused therein, he could not appear in the Court and was ultimately declared to

be proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel further contends that no independent FIR under Section 174-A IPC has been registered so far.

Notice of motion for 20.04.2018.

Till the next date of hearing, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI- Ravinder Singh submits that till date FIR under Section 174-A IPC has not been registered, but the same is under process.

In view of above, let the petitioner join trial proceedings of FIR No. 312 dated 10.11.2013 under Section 304-A IPC and Sections 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Uchana, District Jind on executing fresh bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

In the event of registration of FIR under Section 174-A IPC, the petitioner may avail the legal remedy available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
