Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 112 dated 23.7.2014, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 379, 427, 506, 447, 448, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana City District Ludhiana.

On 15.3.2018, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon pendency of CRM-M No. 7980 of 2018.

Notice of motion for 18.04.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 19.03.2018 at 11.00 A.M. and in the

event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard with CRM-M No.7980 of 2018.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Tarsem Singh, submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 19.3.2018 and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 15.3.2018 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
