This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre arrest bail in case FIR No.248 dated 04.10.2017, under Sections 457/380 IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 15.03.2018:-

“Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.248, dated 04.10.2017, under Sections 457/380 IPC, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Amar Singh as regards theft of a tractor on the intervening night of 3/4.10.2017.

Inter alia contends that main accused,

Mahender and Parman were arrested and recovery of tractor was also effected from them. Present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused.

Notice of motion, returnable for 25.04.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

State counsel upon instructions from HC Satpal, Police Station Rania, apprises the Court that petitioner has since joined investigation.

That apart observations made by this Court in the order dated 15.03.2018 have gone unrebutted.

Petitioner having joined investigation, prayer made in the petition is accepted.

Order dated 15.03.2018, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
