It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined investigation and has also given an affidavit that he has not taken any passport nor is he in possession of the passports, which are alleged to have been handed over to him. This fact is not disputed by counsel for the State, on instructions from, ASI Surat Singh, Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.
