Prayer in this petition is for quashing of the impugned order dated 01.08.2014 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali, dismissing application for discharge, charge-sheet dated 04.03.2016 (Annexure P-6) under Sections 120-B, 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471 in FIR No.02 dated 28.04.2011 (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Punjab State Crime, Mohali and also the impugned order dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Rakesh Kaushal, PPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police, State Crime, SAS Nagar filed on behalf of respondent No.1 in the Court and as per the reply, after passing of the impugned orders, the trial had commenced and the same is pending before the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajender

Singh, submits that only one prosecution witness remained to be examined

as one witness has settled abroad. In view of the same, this petition is rendered infructuous.
