The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.364 dated 21st October, 2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'the IPC') and Sections 324, 201 of the IPC and Section 25-54-59 of the Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

2. The petitioner was arrested on 22nd October, 2017.

3. Challan already submitted after completion of investigation.

4. It transpires that no injury caused to the complainant-victim is specifically attributed to the present petitioner.

5. In the given circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the present petitioner namely Raman Kumar, he may at this stage be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
