RAJ SHEKHAR ATTRI, J. (ORAL):

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0005 dated 18.01.2018, registered under Sections 420/406 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City-I, Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the complainant has placed on record the photocopy of the committee constituted by Deputy Commissioner, Mansa, dated 16.04.2018 and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the parties.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioners is that they along with

other persons had misappropriated a sum of ₹ 18 lacs as per financial report.

Nothing is to be recovered from them. Charges are yet to be framed.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners Chiman Lal and Avtar Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa, subject to following terms:-

- 1.The petitioners shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- 2.In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioners shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel their bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure their presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioners shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- 3.They shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
