ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.153 dated 06.11.2016, under Sections 323, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the neighbours in which no injury was caused to any of the parties. The matter has now been compromised between the parties.

3. A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 15.03.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate,

Kharar dated 19.04.2018 has been received, wherein it is stated that in

pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

4. The FIR is outcome of a sudden quarrel between the neighbours in which no injury was caused to any of the parties.

5. In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed FIR No.153 dated 06.11.2016, under Sections 323, 336, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
