These two petitions arise out of 'cross criminal proceedings'
initiated by one party against the other, the first set of proceedings being by
way of FIR no.59 dated 07.09.2016 (subject matter of CRM-M-1007 of

2017) and the other being in the context of DDR no.31 dated 07.09.2016 (subject matter of CRM-M-1009-2017), both registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib'.

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 28.09.2017, the statements of the petitioners in these cases have been recorded before the SDJM, Gidderbaha, to the effect that they have compromised the dispute with each other of their own free will and as per the assessment of the learned Magistrate, the compromise has been effected so that they may live harmoniously without any conflict or enmity between them.

That being so, the petitions are allowed and FIR no.59 dated 07.09.2016, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and DDR no.31 dated 07.09.2016, also alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, both registered at the same Police Station, Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, are hereby quashed along with all proceedings arising therefrom.
