The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.169 dated 12.09.2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 15 and 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short, 'the Act') at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

It has been submitted that earlier petitioner was granted bail by this court but he absented himself. He absconded the proceedings more than twice.

Keeping in view the conduct of the petitioner and also considering the contraband recovered falls within commercial quantity, petitioner is not entitled to concession of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
