The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in complaint case No.803 dated 14.05.2013, titled as M/s Goel Trading Company versus Varun Kumar, filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

In compliance of order dated 26.09.2018, passed by this Court, report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has been received. Same is taken on record.

As per the said report, the petitioner is now appearing before the learned trial court.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 15.03.2018 is made

absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed. However, the learned trial court is
directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same as early as possible
preferably within a period of 03 months.
