Allegations in the FIR are to the effect that petitioner appeared in the examination on behalf of his brother Sandeep Kumar who had applied for the post of driver as per advertisement issued by Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula. Admit card was issued in the name of Sandeep Kumar, carrying photograph of the petitioner. Affixation of photograph was done by way of impersonation and cheating. Petitioner appeared on behalf of Sandeep Kumar in the examination and ultimately, cleared the examination on behalf of Sandeep Kumar.

Initially, interim bail was granted by the Court of Sessions in favour of the petitioner, but thereafter, on receiving CCTV footage of the examination centre, the same was

cancelled after finding sufficient *prima facie* material in order to link the commission of offence viz-a-viz the petitioner. Police needs custodial interrogation in order to ascertain the background and involvement of any other person in the commission of offence.

No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail. The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
