The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.148 dated 02.12.2010 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab.

Heard.

It is the allegation that petitioner who is a migrant labour has received Rs.90,000/- in advance from his employer and left the work without returning the amount.

Keeping in view of the circumstances of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail subject to payment of Rs.15,000/- and subject to his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to following terms:-

(a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.

(b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.

(c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
