The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.4 dated 07.01.2018 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Pasyana, District Patiala.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 16.03.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation on 23.03.2018 and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.
