The petitioner having been admitted to anticipatory bail by the trial court itself earlier, his bail and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited upon him not having appeared before that Court on 19.07.2017, with the matter then adjourned to 05.08.2017. Very obviously, the petitioner has not been appearing right since then before the trial court.

In the aforesaid circumstances, I see no reason to entertain this petition. Accordingly, it is dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial court and filing an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C., that would be dealt with wholly on its own merits, looking at the reasoning given by the petitioner for non-appearance before that Court.
