Petitioner seeks interim bail for a period of four weeks to participate in the marriage ceremony of his daughter which is stated to be scheduled for 28.03.2018.

Petitioner is an accused in FIR No.99 dated 14.07.2016, under Sections 21 (B), 21 (C), 22(A), 22 (C) and 29 of the NDPS Act and Section 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra and is currently lodged at District Jail, Kurukshetra.

Notice of motion was issued in the instant petition on 16.03.2018.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Pal informs the Court that the factum of marriage ceremony of the daughter of the petitioner to be held on 28.03.2018 has been verified. It has also been verified that the petitioner as of date does not hold a valid passport.

Prayer for interim bail is not seriously opposed by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is partly accepted.

Petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail for a period of 05 days commencing w.e.f. 26.03.2018 subject to imposition of stringent conditions to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petitioner would report back to the jail authorities, Kurukshetra by 5:00 p.m. on 30.03.2018.
