This is the second petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of bail in FIR No.208 dated 17.08.2016, registered under Sections 304 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at P.S. Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the UT Administration, on instructions, informs that statements of all the prosecution witnesses as well as of the accused, under Section 313 Cr.P.C., already stand recorded.
