The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.200, dated 25.08.2017, under sections 148/149/379-A/436 IPC and section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal and sections 120-B/34/188 IPC and section 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act (added later on) and sections 148/149/379-A IPC and section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, were deleted during investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that a sum of Rs.50,000/- has been deposited by the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above fact, the petition is allowed. Petitioners- Balbir son of Sh. Hari Singh and Dharampal son of Sh. Dheerja, are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Kaithal.
