RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.12 dated 12.01.2018, registered under Sections 148, 149, 186, 225, 332, 353, 307 IPC and under Section 3 of the PDPP Act at Police Station Nissing, Karnal.

Allegations are of attacking the police party, when the police party visited the house of the petitioner in connection of FIR No.34 dated 10.01.2018 under Section 18 of the NDPS Act in which disclosure statement was made by one Sahib Singh in respect of involvement of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no specific part has been attributed to the petitioner viz-a-viz. the injury inflicted on the person of ASI Ramphal. Petitioner is in custody since 16.01.2018. It would be debatable as to the culpability in terms of Section 307 IPC.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Krishan Kumar submitted that the case is still under investigation, where five of the co-accused are yet to be arrested.

Taking into consideration the material on record at this stage and without adverting to the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
