ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.3 dated 11.01.2018, registered under Sections 354-A, 506 IPC and Sections 3(1) 3(2) of the SC/ST Act added subsequently, Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 18.01.2018 and compromise has been effected and a petition seeking quashing of the FIR based on the compromise had been filed and notice had been issued for 02.04.2018.

Mr. D.S. Sidhu, Advocate has put in appearance and filed memorandum of appearance on behalf of complainant, which is taken on record. He supports the petitioner and says that a compromise has been effected. Counsel refers to Annexure P-2.

In view of the above circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
