This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 200 dated 27.07.2017 under Sections 354/ 506/ 341 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala.

This Court was pleased to pass the following order on 16.03.2018 :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been compromised between the parties as would be evident from Annexure P-2 and prays for grant of anticipatory bail. It is also submitted that the petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Notice of motion for 21.05.2018.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State confirms the factum of joining investigation by the petitioner.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 16.03.2018 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
