Petitioner-Dilbagh Singh has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.107 dated 06.06.2016, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, under Sections 302, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that firstly, the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. The main accused are Sukhwinder Kaur and Balraj Singh. As per the FIR, murder of Satinderjit Kaur was committed

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by Sukhwinder Kaur, daughter-in-law of the complainant alongwith one Balraj as they had illicit relations and the deceased had seen them in a compromising position and had made a movie in the mobile phone. The complainant has been examined in the Court alongwith another witness, but they have not named the present petitioner.

The petitioner has been in custody since 12.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
