The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 176 dated 26.12.2013 registered under Sections 294, 509, 506 IPC and Section 66-A of Income Tax Act, 2000 at Police Station 'E' Division, Amritsar City, on the basis of compromise dated 05.03.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 19.03.2018, report dated 22.05.2018 has been received from Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at without any threat or coercion.
