This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail has been filed by petitioner-Rishipal in case FIR No.389 dated 19.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) was registered at Police Station City Karnal, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471/34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contents that the allegations in the FIR, are that the accused duped the complainant by issuing fake insurance policy. He has referred to the contents of the FIR and submitted that there is no allegation against the petitioner of having issued the fake insurance policy and the said allegations are against the other accused namely; Vikas Sharma and the petitioner has been involved

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by stating that Vikas Sharma used to work for the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 27.09.2017. Investigation is complete and the challan has already been presented in the Court.

Learned State counsel submits that report from the FSL, Madhuban regarding the handwriting of the petitioner is still awaited.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has not signed any of the alleged fake insurance policies and the FSL report will not be helpful in investigation or the trial in any manner and without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to order release of the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial/Area/Illaq Magistrate concerned at Karnal.
