This petition is directed against the order dated 26.4.1994.

The respondents were desirous of having a path to their lands which has been provided by virtue of the impugned order through the land of the petitioner on the premise that doing so would not result in any bifurcation. The order has been passed under Section 42 of the East Punjab Holdings (Consolidation and Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948. The petitioner has objected to this course being adopted by stating that path can be provided to the respondents through the area belonging to some other persons namely Balbir Singh, Mukhtiar Singh who are of course not parties to the proceedings.

There has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the previous date of hearing. Even today none appeared on his behalf.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
