Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.97 dated 31.08.2017, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Khamanon, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 2 liters of intoxicating liquid was effected and as per Chemical Examiner report, the contents were found to be containing Oxytocin and Morphine Sulphate.

In view of the heavy/commercial quantity allegedly effected from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner benefit of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
