The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.347 dated 27.08.2017, under Sections 420, 426 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

It is contended by learned Counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and he has not committed any fraud. It is further contended that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are false and baseless. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2018 and the case is at the stage of recording of prosecution evidence.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Nafe Singh, by submitting that the

challan stands presented on 16.02.2018, charges were framed on 26.04.2018 and out of total 17 prosecution witnesses, 08 witnesses have been examined till date.

Heard learned Counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

Keeping in view the facts that the the petitioner is in custody since 08.01.2018, charges were framed on 26.04.2018 and out of total 17 prosecution witnesses, only 08 have been examined till date and the trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted. Petitioner-Vijay Kumar be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
