Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 10.10.2016 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh states that as against total 27 witnesses so cited by the prosecution, as many as 12 witnesses have already been examined, whereas 10 witnesses have been given up. Thus, only 05 witnesses are required to be examined and the case is now fixed for 17.10.2018 for prosecution evidence.

In view of the advanced stage of the trial, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to complete the trial within a period of three months from today.
