Application is allowed subject to just exceptions. Ownership of house in dispute is taken on record as Annexure P-3 and filing of certified copy and fair typed copy of the same is dispensed with.

CRM-M-11388-2018

It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that despite having submitted a detailed representation highlighting her grievance to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No. 2 on 12.02.2018 (Annexure P-1), copy whereof has been sent to the Station House Officer, Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar-respondent No. 3, no action thereon has been taken till date. He contends that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to these respondents to look into the representation of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the

Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No. 2 and the Station House Officer, Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 12.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if required.
