JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the order dated 20.01.2009 (Annexure P-3) to the extent of declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.06.2017, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and she was ready to face trial and had been admitted to bail till the next date of hearing before this Court i.e. today itself. Counsel for the petitioner also submits that the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 20.01.2018 and prays that the petitioner should not be arrested in the meantime as she is ready to face trial.

Since the petitioner has surrendered and ready to face trial, the

order dated 20.01.2009 to the extent of declaring the petitioner a proclaimed offender is quashed. The petitioner who has appeared before the trial Court and has furnished bail bonds be admitted to bail on her furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
