Petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 7 on the ground that the petitioner had purchased a vehicle and had also availed loan facility from respondent No.7.

Petitioner has already paid the loan installments but “No Due Certificate” has not been issued by respondent No.7 on the ground that thirteen installments have not been received by the Bank though the same were paid through respondent No.4.

Precisely for the grievance in question, a complaint was moved before respondent No.3 on 02.07.2015 and

thereafter, a representation (Annexure P-4) was filed before respondent No.2, but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing any reply, as no order prejudicial to the interest of either party is being passed.

Without meaning anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to have a fair look on the representation made by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of fact made hereinabove.
