Joint affidavit of the petitioners filed today in Court is taken on record.

Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 10 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh-respondent No.2.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh-respondent No.2, to look into the representation dated 13.03.2018, Annexure P-5, and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh and Station House Officer, Police Station Industrial Area, U.T., Chandigarh, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to look into the representation dated 13.03.2018, Annexure P-5, and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
