1. On earlier occasion, the petitioner absented on 02.02.2017. His bail was cancelled and he was declared as proclaimed offender. Thereafter, the petitioner surrendered on 28.08.2017 and ultimately, regular bail was granted by the High Court on 15.11.2017 subject to executing bail bonds and two local sureties with heavy amount.

2. Again the petitioner absented on the ground that his counsel had recorded wrong date as 28.02.2018 instead of 27.02.2018. His bail has been cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds have been forfeited to the State.

3. Non-bailable warrants have been issued for 20.03.2018.

4. Notices have already been issued to the sureties.

5. In view of facts on record, let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on the date fixed i.e. 20.03.2018 and in the event of his appearance and filing an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law preferably within 07 days.
