Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.38 dated 29.1.2018 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar.

Pursuant to the order dated 29.5.2018 passed by this Court, the State counsel has produced a photocopy of the report of FSL followed by a communication dated 7.8.2018 issued by the Medical Officer, Civil Hospital, Phillaur wherein the doctor has opined that the cause of death in this case is due to cardio respiratory arrest due to neuromuscular paralytic bite which can be due to neuromuscular paralytic snake bite.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Bakshish Singh, Sub Inspector, Police Station, Phillaur, has stated that in terms of order dated

his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.4.2018 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
