The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 23rd April, 2017, registered under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga.

2 On 14th May, the matter was adjourned in view of the submission made by Ld. State Counsel to the effect that a wrong noting of the date of hearing had been taken by the Investigating Officer.

3. The petitioner was arrested on 23rd April, 2017.
4. It further transpires from the submission of the Ld. Counsel for the State that after evidence of the complainant as PW-1 was recorded on 23rd March, 2018, an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has now been moved to summon certain other accused persons who happen to be own sons of the petitioner.
5. Undoubtedly, there is delay involved on account of filing of such application mid-way through the trial.
6. Considering the very old age of the petitioner, who according to his Aadhar Card was born in the year 1944, and the period of detention already undergone by him, at this stage he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
