AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are being harassed unnecessarily at the behest of respondent No.4, who has some dispute with Rakesh Garg, who is the husband of petitioner No.3 and father of petitioners 1 and 2. Time and again, petitioners are being called to the Police Post Dhakoli, Zirakpur, by the Incharge of the said Police Post. He contends that this process is continuing for quite some time and the petitioners have been cooperating with the same but without any settlement of the dispute. Counsel contends that the petitioners have nothing to do with the matter in question except that they are related to Mr. Rakesh Garg, as has been noted above.

Counsel thus contends that the petitioners are ready and willing to cooperate in the inquiry/investigation provided they are given proper notice as per the provisions of law.

Keeping in view the assertions of the counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioners are required for inquiry/investigation relating to any complaint, proper notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to them.
