This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 with a further direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Jind by way of her representation dated 06.02.2018 (Annexure P-1) for redressal of her grievances. However, the said representation is still pending consideration and no action has been taken thereunder so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would feel satisfied, at the present moment, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decided the said representation expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let adequate copies of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which, no action is called for.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Jind to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
