This order shall dispose of Criminal Misc. M- Nos. 11607, 12313 and 3662 of 2016. All the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 147 dated 13.12.2015 under Sections 376, 342, 506, 147, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 28.02.2018 of Smt. Alka Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib filed in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the State while referring to para 5 of the affidavit dated 28.02.2018 points out that all the three petitioners i.e. Darshan Singh, Kuldeep Kaur and Sarpreet Singh have since been acquitted by the learned trial Court on 17.02.2018.

It is mentioned in the said affidavit that property of the co-accused Baba Major Singh has been ordered to be attached vide order dated 11.12.2017. All possible efforts are being made to trace out the said co-accused as well as the husband of the complainant and it is assured that necessary action shall be taken in this regard.

It is submitted that in view of the acquittal of all the petitioners, present petitions have been rendered infructuous.
