The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for quashing of the FIR No. 32 dated 29.4.2017 registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station Jhander, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations, as set out in the FIR, are improbable and that in fact, the matter has been settled between the parties. It is also argued that the challan has not been put up so far. The complainant, in fact, has sworn an affidavit, which would reflect that the allegations that were raised were only on account of a property dispute between the two political factions.

At this stage, appearance has been caused on behalf of the complainant through Mr. Amandeep Chhabra, Advocate, who has tendered his power of attorney and admits to the affidavit having been sworn by the

complainant. It is stated that the complainant does not want to pursue with the FIR and the same should be quashed.

Since the challan has not been presented so far and the matter is still under investigation, the parties are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer and get their statements recorded, who will then look into the matter.

With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
