By this common order this Court proposes to dispose of all the
above mentioned three petitions.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 47 dated 20.01.2018, registered under Section 323, 354-B, 406, 498-A, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.

It is contended that during the pendency of the proceedings, the matter had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the matter has been settled vide Settlement Agreement dated 27.08.2018 by which the parties have decided to part their ways and that the petitioner-husband would pay a sum of ₹80 Lacs as full and final settlement with regard to all disputes with the complainant and also, as permanent alimony for past, present and future maintenance.

In view of the fact that the matter stands settled between the parties, the instant petitions stands allowed granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners and orders granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
