In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.229, dated 22.07.2017, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station 31, Chandigarh.

2. The petitioner was originally arrested on 22.07.2017, was thereafter granted interim bail and then surrendered before the Ld. Trial Court as required of him at the time of his release on interim bail.

3. The petitioner has by now undergone imprisonment for almost six months. There is no record of his involvement in any other case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, and investigation in the present case is already complete with the challan having

been submitted.

4. As such, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Kamal Kishore son of Yogeshwar Prashad, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
