Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for
quashing of criminal complaint No.137 dated 06.08.2005 (Annexure P-11)
as well as summoning order dated 25.03.2006 (Annexure P-14) and all

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of compromise so arrived at between the parties on 26.12.2015, the complaint (Annexure P-11) filed by the respondent-Iqbal Singh Dhillon under Section 200 of Cr.P.C. read with Sections 379, 420, 467, 468 & 471 of IPC, is liable to be dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent does not dispute the compromise dated 26.12.2015 (Annexure A-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner shall withdraw the appeal No.1332 of 2007 titled as Sukhwant Singh Versus the State of Maharashtra and another, which is pending before the Bombay High Court and undertakes not to retract from this statement.

In view of the submission so made by learned counsel for the petitioner which is not controverted by the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent, the criminal complaint No.137 dated 06.08.2005 (Annexure P-11) is hereby quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner Sukhwant Singh Dhadda, however, that would be subject to payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, within one month from today.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed. The parties shall adhere to the compromise as entered between them in letter and spirit.
