RAMENDRA JAIN, J.

Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought issuance of direction to the respondents to stop harassing them under the garb of second investigation; to stop the illegal second investigation and not to harass them in case FIR No.1 dated 07.01.2017 registered under Sections 406,420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Nayagaon, District Mohali.

On 06.04.2007, a Coordinate Bench of this Court transferred the investigation to Special Investigation Team comprising ADGP (Crime) Punjab and Inspector General of Police (Crime), Punjab with a direction to respondent No.2 to dispatch all files/record pertaining to this case forthwith to the Special Investigation Team aforesaid, who submitted its status report on

03.07.2017. Thereafter, petitioner filed objection time and again without any fruitful hearing.

Heard.

There is a provision under the Code of Criminal Procedure to lay challenge to the cancellation report and final report under Section 173 (3) Cr.P.C. Therefore, the SIT is directed to furnish its final outcome before the trial Court within four weeks from today, failing which the SIT would entail appropriate action against all its members for defiance of this order.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to lay challenge, if they so desire.
