Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.136 dated 22.05.2017, registered at Police Station Tripuri Patiala, District Patiala, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a house wife; her husband-Sunil Narula expired on 04.04.2017 and after that, this FIR has been registered against her.

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I have gone through the FIR. The general allegations are levelled against Paramjit Kaur Narula (present petitioner), Sunil Narula and Parerna Narula in respect of taking money and providing job.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 20.03.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 20.03.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
