In compliance of order dated 30.10.2018, passed by this Court, affidavit of Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana alongwith documents Annexures R1/T and R-2 has been filed. Same are taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.43 dated 17.05.2013, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith Jagtar Singh and Sukhpal Singh had purchased wood from the complainant and issued a demand draft for a sum of Rs.5,70,000/-. The said demand draft was found to be forged. Now wood has been recovered from co-accused.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more

required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 21.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
