The instant application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking permission to place on record all Zimni orders till today passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ferozepur in criminal complaint No. 201 of 2017.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the accompanied documents are taken on record subject to all just exceptions. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.
