The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case First Information Report No.251 dated 26.11.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Division 6, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance of order dated 23.03.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel. On instructions from ASI Harpreet Singh, he

submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.03.2018 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
