Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.53 dated 09.06.2017, under Sections 15 and 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the commercial vehicle in which the petitioner was also seated was of 112 kgs of poppy husk and 120 grams of intoxicant powder and which upon receipt of report of the Chemical Examiner was found to be containing 'Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride'.

The recovery effected from the petitioner would be construed as commercial in nature.

In view of the specific bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the concession of bail.

Petition dismissed.
