Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 not to summon the petitioners without issuing notices under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that an application was filed against petitioner No.1 and his wife Saroj Bala by Avtar Singh before the Superintendent of Police (D), Fatehgarh Sahib. The said application was referred to the A.S.I., Economic Offences Wing for investigation. The A.S.I. recommended for consigning of the application. The said recommendation of A.S.I. was accepted by S.S.P. On 06.11.2017.

The grievance of the petitioners is that despite consigning of application of Avtar Singh, respondent No.3 is still pressurizing the petitioners to attend his office.

In view of aforesaid facts, let the petitioners make a detailed representation before respondent No.2. In the event of filing such a representation, the same shall be decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law.
